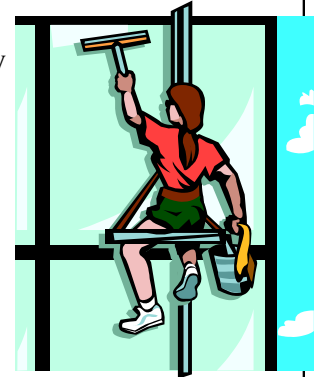
## VOCATIONAL SERVICE AND HIGH ETHICAL STANDARDS



Historically, Rotarians have promoted the practice of high ethical standards as part of their commitment to vocational service. Two tools developed by Rotarians—The Four-Way Test and the Declaration of Rotarians in Businesses and Professions—provide a road map for practicing ethical behaviour in the workplace and other areas of life.

### The Four-Way Test

The Four-way Test was conceived in 1932 by Herbert J. Taylor, a member of the Rotary Club of Chicago who served as the 1954-55 president of Rotary International. Having been assigned the task of saving a company from bankruptcy, Taylor developed the test as an ethical guide to follow in all business matters. The company's survival was credited to this simple philosophy. Adopted by Rotary International in 1934, The Four-Way Test remains an essential standard against which Rotarians measure ethical behaviour. The test has been translated into dozens of languages and promoted by Rotarians worldwide.

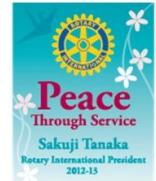
