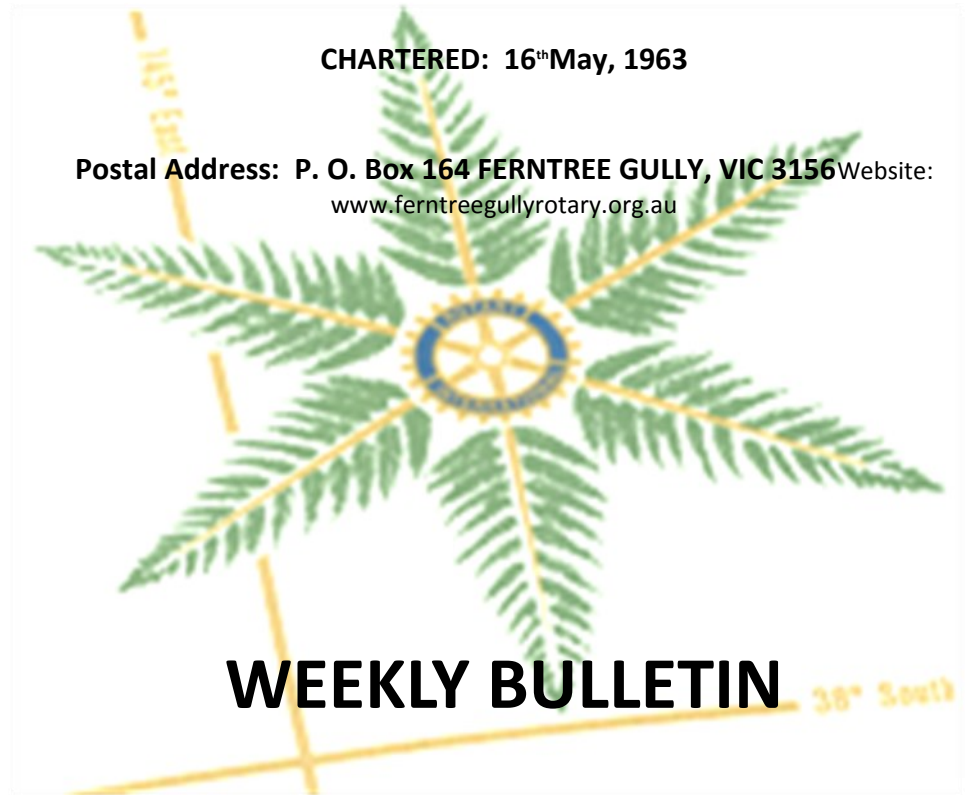

Virginia—too late for the 4-way test.

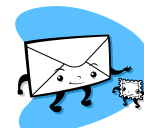
Fran—*Are You Being Served*—confirmed as 15th November. Seats available.

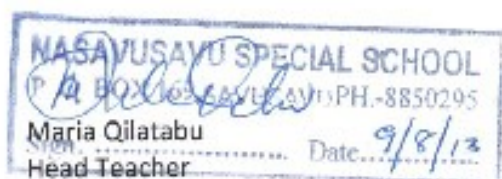
