PROGRAM: Swags for the Homeless—Lisa Clark

With her husband Tony Lisa is the co-designer and co-founder of Swags for the Homeless.

- 315 new homeless per day (41,000 sleep out per year)
- 80% turned away from shelters
- Hypothermia etc. are illnesses contracted by sleeping out
- Statistics only gathered on a daily basis, unfortunately.
- Showed prior "handouts" - mainly reject materials.
- A new Swag is distributed through other agencies (280 in Australia). A swag is given when one is turned away.
- 91% expect to be still on the street a week from now.
- 7,500 Swags have been given out in Australia with more in other countries.
- Swag/bed has received design awards for its utility and fit for purposes.

There were many searching questions, all answered by Lisa.

This is a social enterprise that will progress.
