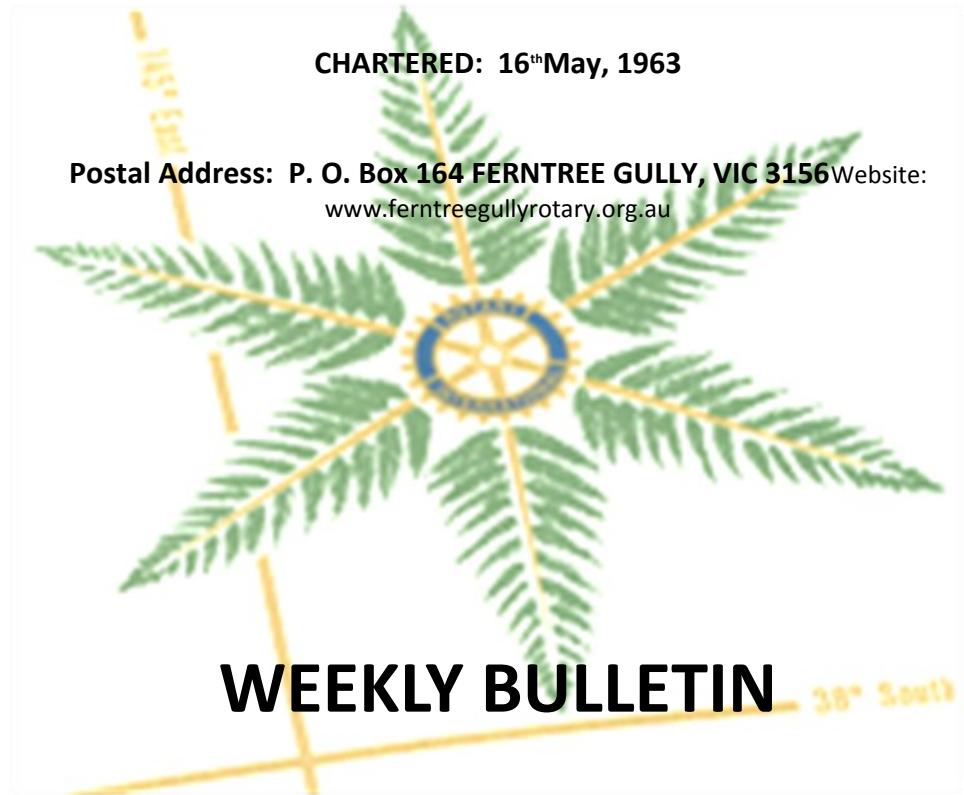

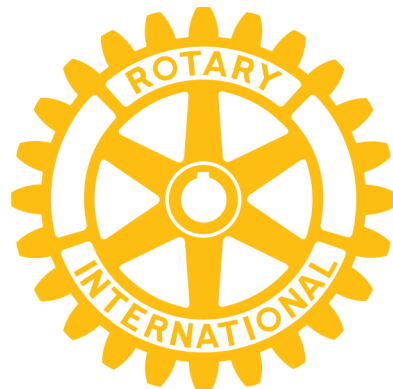

CITY2SEA FUN RUN

17th November 2013

We need Volunteers to help run the City2Sea Fun Run. The Event is on November 17th.

We are now needing volunteers rather desperately for the Sunday 17th November effort. Admittedly it is a very early start on the Sunday morning with times from 5:00am through to 6:00am for set –up and then work to assist participants through the morning. However if a District 9810 Club or any other organisation is interested that would be good for Rotary and them.

The Event is an opportunity for your Club Members to volunteer and assist with the City2Sea Fun Run for which Fairfax Media pays helpers acting either as Marshals or Drink Station Attendants.

Starting at the Arts Centre, the 14km course covers some of Melbourne's greatest landmarks before a spectacular finish on the beach in St Kilda. Runners can also choose to take on a more leisurely 5km course featuring a lap of the Australian Grand Prix circuit at Albert Park. The Sunday Age City2Sea aims to raise funds for a range of charities including Movember, a global movement aimed at changing the face of men's health.

District 9800 needs to provide up to 450 Volunteers on the morning of Sunday 17th November 2013. The main roles required include those of Marshals and Drink Station Attendants. The rate for Marshals is \$55 per person and for Drink Station Attendants \$30 (as per the rates in 2012 when we last volunteered)

The money is paid to your Club and can greatly assist in supporting one of your own favourite projects.

Could I please kindly ask for your help on this one. We are desperately in need of some more helpers.

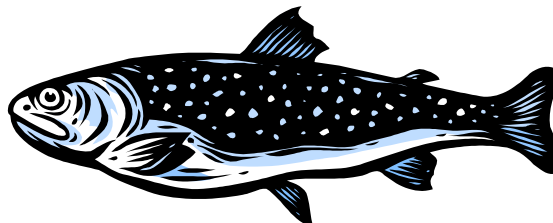
