



As this bulletin goes to air President Mike is speeding down the highway on his way home from Queensland. So, no "Musing this week".



He started as a volunteer with Boronia CFA in 1980, however after suffering severe heart problems he now prefers to speak

about fire safety rather than fighting them.

- They average 1100 call outs per year.
- John spoke of the importance of fire safety in the home and the need for working smoke detectors.
- The major cause of fires in the home are started by smoking in bed, cooking oil on stoves, dirty heating ducts and dryers full of lint.
- As we all live within the Dandenong ranges, and there are 60,000 registered cars in the hills area, he stressed the importance of "leaving early" whenever there was an alert warning.

President Mike thanked John for speaking to the club, read out the housekeeping for the coming week, then closed the meeting at 8:35pm.
