
ROTIARIANS AGAINST MALARIA

All in all a very comprehensive update on what's happening in regard to this program


PROGRAM:

Past Pres. Gloria Hargreaves from the Rotary club of Emerald (also a Past Assistant Governor) spoke to us in her capacity as the District Chairperson for Rotarians Against Malaria (RAM) program. This program was started by the Rotary club of Port Moresby in 2004 and has spread throughout the South Pacific. The World Health Organisation (WHO) estimated that there were 207 million cases of malaria and 627,000 deaths from the disease in 2012.

It appears from Gloria's talk that the RAM program has had a significant impact on malaria in our region where the rate of infection has dropped from 702 to .04 cases per 1000 people since 1998/99. One of the most effective methods developed is the provision of insecticide treated netting to households.
