Rotary's early emblem was a simple wagon wheel (in motion with dust). It was designed in 1905 by Montague M. Bear, a member of the Rotary Club of Chicago who was an engraver. He designed the emblem to represent both civilization and movement. Most of the early Rotary clubs adopted the wheel in one form or another. The present emblem, 24 cogs and six spokes, was adopted in 1924. A keyway was added to signify usefulness. An official description of the emblem was adopted at the 1929 International Convention.

NASAVUSAVU—HOW THEY FARED!

Thank you to everyone for the outpouring of concern after TC Winston blew thru our island paradise and reduced much of it to rubble! A week later and we are still assessing the damage and what needs to be done. Many of our Rotarians suffered damage to their homes and properties as well and we are all a bit traumatized by the event. Power, water and communications are still a bit dodgy and it may be some time before we are back to normal.

We received 49 ERK (emergency response kits) that had been held in Labasa and Sharad Solanki along with Ron & Claire Voldeng with Sgt. Sanaila delivered 44 of them yesterday to homeowners that have been in evacuation centers at Savusavu Secondary School (1 + 2 to be delivered to those not there at the time), Khemendra School (9) and Naweni School (37 for households from Naweni Village). These were chosen under the recommendation of District Officer Bale and Dismac.

Through Rotary Labasa there are 125 -130 food packets that came down from Labasa and are in Gulabdas Hardware container and Rotary Labasa due to arrive tomorrow to deliver them.

We are still waiting to deploy 10 of our Safe Water Stations to Nukubalavu village and find out what other needs we may be able to help with. We are also considering setting up a "Go Fund Me" page on FaceBook for those folks who would like to help by making donations for the recovery effort.
