Skill: Mike Spark won the swindle and drew the queen of clubs.

PROGRAM:

Martin Boettcher was our guest speaker and he spoke about turbine generator failures. Martin had a novel approach he asked questions about turbine and if you got the question right you were rewarded with a box of Maltesers.

Causes of failures:

- Stem valves not being checked and the valve can seize up resulting in an explosion in the generator.
- Hydrogen explosion: Hydrogen is used to keep the generator cool. When hydrogen and oxygen are mixed it can have dire results.
- Blade fatigue cracking.
- Penstock failure on hydro turbine: Sixty to seventy people were killed and the whole plant was destroyed. This was caused by a blockage in the pipe, that provides water to the generator.
- Turbine generator motoring: This is caused by the blades in the turbine melting.
- Maintenance equipment failure.
- Coupling failure: Bolts fail which causes the machine to go out of alignment.
- Turbine failures cost millions of dollars and keep plants out of action for a long time.
- Martin gave a very interesting talk and this was evidenced by the large number of questions.
