Tuesday, 27th June 2017



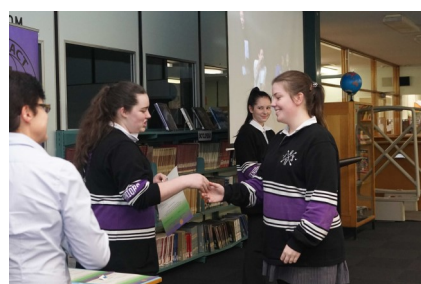
Two years ago the Rotary Club of Fern Tree Gully received a request from Fairhills High-school asking us to assist them with a Community Service Tour to Thailand. Club members discussed this and decided that not only did we want to help with the Thailand project but that we would like to expand this request into a partnership whereby we could offer Fairhills the raft of fantastic Youth Programs that Rotary offers. Subsequently, later that year the students along with school Principal Harvey Wood and Teacher Adrienne Tanner presented their Thailand project to the club.



And the partnership was born.

So far, RC FTG have :-

- Sponsored Callum McLachland in a Rotary public speaking competition (based on Rotary's 4-way test);
- Sponsored four students to a 2-day residential development course (RYPEN—Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment)
- Given a donation to the school's Thailand trip



Following all of this the club escalated its vision which culminated in a formal meeting with the school's Principal who sanctioned the formation of an Interact Club at Fairhills.



None of this would have happened without the support of all involved but especially, Salwan Shahine, Adrienne Tanner and my fellow club members.
